Directions: From Highway 7, go north on Kennedy Road. Camp Woodland Trails will be on the right hand-side just pass Vandorf Road.

Drop-off time:

- If your child is camping the entire weekend, please drop them off between 7:00 till 7:30 p.m. on Friday, November 14
- If your child is only participating on Saturday, please drop them off at 9:00 a.m. on November 15

Drop-off location:

- Big Pine Lodge

Drop-off Instructions:

- Dinner **will not** be served on Friday. Make sure your child had dinner before heading to camp.
- Cars **are not allowed** to drive to the lodge. Please park your car at the parking lot and walk (about 5 minutes) to Big Pine Lodge.
- Once at Big Pine Lodge, please **register** your child at the desk.

Pick-up time:

- If your child is camping the entire weekend, pick up time is 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 16
- If your child is only attending Saturday, pick up time is either 3:30 p.m. (after the last event) or 7:00 p.m. (after dinner)
- We have to be out of the lodge at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday so **please pick-up your child on time.**

What to Bring:

€ Outdoor Fall Clothing	€ Mess kit (plate, bowl, cup and utensils)
○ Rain or Winter Boots	€ Flashlight with new batteries (bring extra batteries as well)
○ Coat	€ Whistle
○ Hat(s)	€ Ground Mat/Sheet (for Scouts and Vents only)
○ Gloves	€ Sleeping bag
€ Grooming kit	€ Pillow
○ Toothbrush	€ Indoor shoes (for Beavers & Cubs - for sleeping area and dining area)
○ Toothpaste	€ Cub or Scout Book
○ Soap	€ Pen or pencil
○ Face cloth or towel	€ One large garbage bag for dirty clothes, etc.
€ Sets of clothes	
○ Pajamas	€ The theme of the camp is Medieval Times. We encourage that your child wear a costume on Saturday that is related to the theme.
○ Underwear	
○ Lots of Socks	
○ Pants	
○ Shirt	
○ Long sleeve shirt or sweater	

Note:

1. If your child has any allergy and carries an EpiPen, please inform the leader at the registration desk. One EpiPen should be with your child at all times and another with the leader in charge.
2. Any medication that your child will require should be sent in the original container clearly marked with the child's name and instructions.
3. Please remember to label all of your child's belongings with their complete name and group (i.e. 7th Markham Beavers)
