Group Hike at Seaton Trail

Date: Tuesday, 29 September 2015

Time: 6:30 PM - 7:30 PM Where: Seaton Trail

 The best way to get there will be to take 14th Avenue eastbound until it ends at the York/Durham Line. Turn left (North) and then turn right (East) on 5th Concession Road. Whitevale Park will be on your right (South side of the road) just after Altona Road. If you passed the bridge, you went too far.

- Alternatively, you can go eastbound on Highway 7 or 407 and head South on York/Durham Line. Turn left on 5th Concession Road. Keep going until you see Whitevale Park on your right.
- Unfortunately, there are no street signs in the area so it is easy to get lost. Give yourself enough time to get there.

Note: •

- Please have your child wear a good pair of hiking shoes or an old pair of shoes. Make sure to bring a flashlight, water and a mug (for hot chocolate) and wear weather appropriate clothing.
- Hot chocolate will be provided after the hike.
- Parents and siblings (and family dog) are welcome to join us for the hike.
