Cubs Camp at Camp Warsaw – GC2

Friday, June 9, 7:00 PM to Sunday, June 11, Noon

Cub & Scouts will be sleeping in tents for this camp. On Friday night, we'll set up camp. On Saturday, have breakfast and pack a lunch and then cave exploring and canoeing. Snacks will be provided and we'll cook dinner over a campfire. On Sunday, we'll have breakfast and snack, and then tear down our camp. The fee is \$60 per Cub/Scouts. Please make the cheque payable to "Scouts Canada – 7th Markham." **Deadline for registration is June 2nd.**

Drop-off: Friday, 9 June 2017, 7:00 PM, 289 Caves Rd., Douro-Drummer, Ontario. Coordinates: 44.461904,-78.131332. Otonabee Region Conversation Area. Approx. 1 hour 40 minutes from Markham.

Pick-up: Sunday, 11 June 2017, Noon, arriving a bit early for pick-up is OK, arriving late is never OK

Clothes

Friday & Saturday

- Comfortable pants and shirts (worn when they arrive so there is no need to bring an extra set)
- Waterproof jacket, bathing suite, life jacket
- Hoodie / sweatshirt
- Rain gear / poncho
- Pajamas

Sunday

- Pants and shirt
- Underwear and socks

Sleeping

- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping mat
- Small pillow

Equipment

- Mess kit (plate, bowl, cup, spoon, fork and knife)
- Water bottle
- Small survival / personal kit (whistle, compass, flashlight, sunblock, bug repellent and small first aid kit)
- Hygiene kit (toilet paper, wipes, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and face towel)
- Small camp chair
- Medications, if applicable (please let Scouters know)

Parents: It is very important that you **DO NOT PACK** for your children. Put names on each item. Ask them to spread all of the items listed above on the floor and have them check off each item before they put it inside their bag. Everything should fit inside one bag and nothing should be dangling outside. Your child will be carrying the bag so keep it light and compact. Remember that they are going to an overnight camp, not a zombie apocalypse survival camp.

If everything cannot fit inside one bag, either you are sending them with too much stuff or their equipment is way too big (e.g., full size pillow instead of a blow-up pillow). Whatever you do, please help them make everything fit inside one bag that they can carry on their own without help from a Scouter.

You will be asked to drop them off on the parking lot and they need to carry their personal equipment to the campsite. The path from the parking lot to the campsite is a combination of gravel and grass. If you send them with too much stuff, it will not be fun for them. The less they bring, the better.

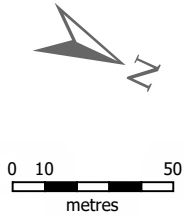
Medication: Please let the Scouters know if your child needs to take prescribed medications.

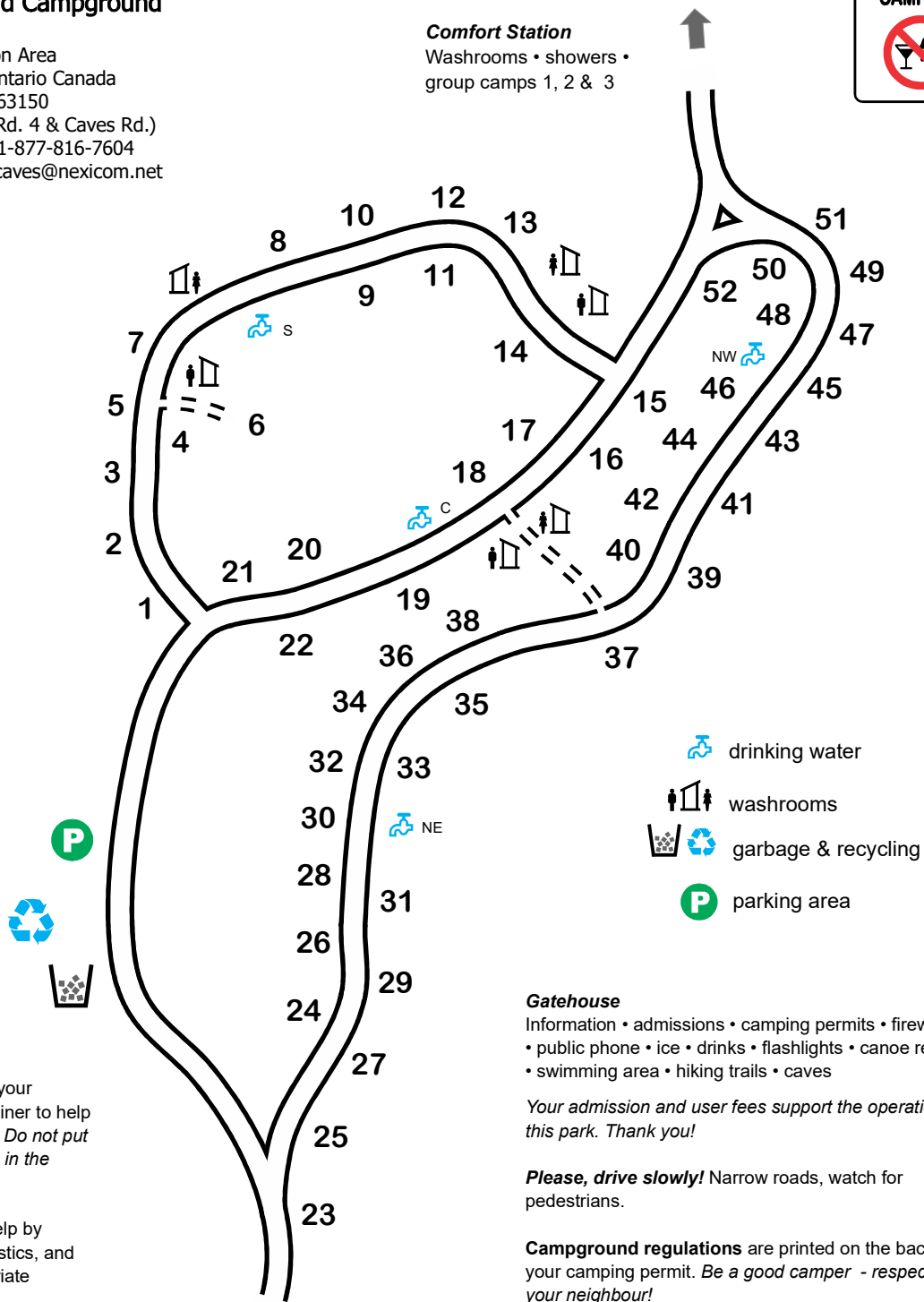

CODE OF CONDUCT

I am personally responsible for my behaviour at the 7th Markham's Camp Warsaw. I understand that each Cub and Scout has the privilege to learn more about Scouting and to enjoy all of the camp activities. In order to make sure this privilege is observed, I will:

1. Show respect to all Scouters, Cub Scouts, Scouts, staff and guests.
2. Put safety first by listening, paying attention and following Scouters instructions promptly and respectfully at all times.
3. Use only appropriate language—any foul, profane or cursing words are not acceptable.
4. Follow the "Hands Off" policy—physical or verbal abuse and fighting or threats against another person is absolutely prohibited.
5. Respect other people's religious, cultural and personal beliefs.
6. Take care of my own equipment.
7. Respect at all times the following:
 - a. Other Scout's personal property
 - b. Group equipment
 - c. Campground equipment
8. Vandalism and/or carelessness of the above listed items will not be tolerated.
9. Be responsible for the repair and/or replacement costs of damages to any property or equipment that I break or lose whether accidental or not.
10. Be helpful to others and work as a team.
11. Have a "buddy" at all times.
12. Always ask for permission before attempting to do something I am unsure of.
13. Always carry my knife permit whenever I have my knife with me (applicable to Scouts).
14. Demonstrate good Scouting spirit and follow the Promise, Law and Motto. There will be zero tolerance for temper tantrums and anger outburst at the camp.

If any of the above rules are broken, the incident will be reviewed by the camp Scouters. If the behaviour/incident is found to be unacceptable, the parent will be called to come and get the participant to be taken home at your own costs with no refund for fees and other costs associated with the activities. The camp Scouters' decision is final.
