As in the past years, the association will be holding a special service at the Veterans Hall located at 7 Washington Street, Markham at 10:00 AM., in the upper hall. Following the service, at approximately 10:30 AM., The Remembrance Day Parade will form up and march to the Cenotaph for the 11:00 AM. Ceremony, and the laying of the wreaths. The parade will return to the Veterans Hall following the ceremony at the Cenotaph.

Upon return to the Markham District Veterans Association, light refreshments will be served in the hall and we cordially invite you to join us.

The following Road Closures are advised to be in effect on November 9 to accommodate the parade to the Cenotaph:

1. 10:00am- 12:30pm Washington St between HWY # 7 and Centre St - hard closure, no vehicle access.
2. 10:00am -12:30pm HWY # 7 closed between Main St Markham and Albert St.
3. 10:00am- 12:30pm Centre St closed between Washington St and Main St.
4. 10:00am-12:30pm at Robinson/Joseph, Main St closed to Southbound traffic.
5. 10:00am – 12:30pm Main St north of Hwy #7 closed to Northbound traffic.
6. 10:40am - Parade departs along parade route.
7. 10:50am - Parade crosses Hwy #7 into Veterans Square (Cenotaph)
8. 11:30am- Parade leaves Cenotaph along HWY #7 turning North on Washington St.
9. Once Parade is safely on Washington St. all closures except Washington St between Hwy #7 and Centre St will be opened
