Who:	Beavers, Cubs, Scouts, Venturers		
Where:	Shadow Lake Camp, 15041 Ninth Line Whitchurch-Stouffville, ON L4A 7X3		
Drop-off time:	 If your child is camping the entire weekend, please drop them off between 7:30 till 8:00 p.m. on Friday. If your child is only participating on Saturday (ie Beavers), please drop them off at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday morning. 		
Drop-off location:	Drop off and registration will be at the Shadow lake lodge. Youth will get their assigned cabins (yes heated cabins!) at that time. Please park in the designated parking lot when dropping off.		
Drop-off Instructions:	Dinner will not be served on Friday. Make sure your child had dinner before heading to camp. Please park your car at the parking lot and walk towards the dining hall. Once at dining hall, please register your child at the desk.		
Pick-up time:	If your child is camping the entire weekend, pick up time will be 10:30 a.m. on Sunday If your child is only attending Saturday, pick up time is 7:00 p.m. (after dinner) or 9pm (after campfire) We have to be out of Shadowlake at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday so please pick-up your child on time.		
Cost:	\$75 per participant (Apple day participants – use your \$25 off coupon if you weren't able to for fall camp). Beavers staying Saturday only: Cost \$40 Venturer helpers: \$50 A signed code of conduct, non-refundable payment (payable to Scouts Canada – 7 th Markham) or e-transfer to bryantfung@hotmail.com and emergency contact information are required Please bring payment and completed forms to the Xmas potluck on Monday, December 16 th 2019. If you are not able to attend the potluck, send me an email/e-transfer and bring the completed form to your meeting Jan 7 th /8 th . Due to limited space, parents or guardians are not allowed to participate in the camp.

Note:	 If your child has any allergy and carries an EpiPen, please inform the Scouter at the registration desk. One EpiPen should be with your child at all times and another with the Scouter in charge. Any medication that your child will require should be sent in the original container clearly marked with the child's name and instructions. 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CODE OF CONDUCT

I am personally responsible for my behaviour at the **7**th **Markham Winter Camp**. I understand that each Beaver, Cub, Scout, Venturer and Rover has the privilege to learn more about Scouting and to enjoy all of the camp activities. In order to make sure this privilege is observed, I will:

- 1. Show respect to all Scouters, Beaver Scouts, Cub Scouts, Scouts, Venturer Scouts, Rover Scouts, staff and guests.
- 2. Put safety first by listening, paying attention and following Scouters instructions promptly and respectfully at all times.
- 3. Use only appropriate language—any foul, profane or cursing words are not acceptable.
- 4. Follow the "Hands Off" policy—physical or verbal abuse and fighting or threats against another person is absolutely prohibited.
- 5. Respect other people's religious, cultural and personal beliefs.
- 6. Take care of my own equipment.
- 7. Respect at all times the following:
 - a. Other Scout's personal property
 - b. Group equipment
 - c. Campground equipment
- 8. Vandalism and/or carelessness of the above listed items will not be tolerated.
- 9. Be responsible for the repair and/or replacement costs of damages to any property or equipment that I break or lose whether accidental or not.
- 10. Be helpful to others and work as a team.
- 11. Have a "buddy" at all times.
- 12. Always ask for permission before attempting to do something I am unsure of.
- 13. Always carry my knife permit whenever I have my knife with me (applicable to Scouts, Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts).
- 14. Demonstrate good Scouting spirit and follow the Promise, Law and Motto. There will be zero tolerance for temper tantrums and anger outburst at the camp.
- 15. Specific to Shadow Lake Camp:
 - a. Stay away from the lake (frozen or not)
 - b. Pay/public telephones located in several location are out-of-bounds to all youth. Misuse or prank use of the telephones will be considered a very serious offense.

If any of the above rules are broken, the incident will be reviewed by the camp Scouters. If the behaviour/incident is found to be unacceptable, the parent will be called to come and get the participant to be taken home at your own costs with no refund for fees and other costs associated with the activities. The camp Scouters' decision is final.
